



“I am in the process of defining”: Monreal accepts candidacy negotiation with “Va por México”

It's more like making her tired. For months there has been speculation about Ricardo Monreal's rapprochement with the opposition. Now it looks more cheeky than anything and recent statements made to *The country* They show that it is only a matter of days.

“I am in that definition process, the last one has not been taken [decisión]”, commented Ricardo Monreal for the Spanish newspaper, which a few days ago announced about the negotiations between the “Va por México” coalition and the leader of Morena in the Senate.

“I have talked with all the parties, I don't like to be ashamed of it, because I don't feel it. Dialogue and talk with political groups other than mine does not make us less”, Monreal added after participating in an inter-parliamentary meeting between Mexico and Spain... an event for which he stopped joining AMLO's march (although it would not have gone well at all, as seen by the cheers that several of the attendees threw).

Miguel Ángel Mancera and Santiago Creel also participated in said interparliamentary meeting. The latter confirmed the approaches that opposition leaders have had with Ricardo Monreal. *“I have been a member of Acción Nacional for many years, but Mexico is above my party”* commented Creel, noting that what is being done with the still Morenista is a “reconciliation” plan.
